

# **Chung Yuan University Radiation Protection Committee Establishment Guidelines**

100.4.14 Passed by the 884th Executive Meeting

Amended based on the original secret letter No. 1050002657 on 105.8.25

106.6.1 Amendment at the 953rd Executive Meeting

Article 1 In order to ensure the health and safety of faculty, staff and students and to prevent the hazards of ionizing radiation, our school has established a "Radiation Protection Committee" (hereinafter referred to as the Committee).

Article 2 The association shall have one chairman, who shall be concurrently served by the principal; nineteen to twenty-three members shall include the director of the Environmental Protection and Safety and Health Center, the dean of the School of Science, the dean of the School of Engineering, the leader of the health care team, the environmental safety The team leader, the unit supervisor who uses radioactive sources and equipment that can generate ionizing radiation, the teacher in charge of the experimental site and the designated radiation protection personnel are ex-officio members. The remaining members are selected by the principal for a one-year term.

Article 3 The tasks of this Association are as follows:

1. Evaluate the radiation protection measures plan.
2. Review the operational abilities and qualifications of radiation workers.
3. Regularly review and revise the radiation protection measures plan.
4. Regularly convene the Radiation Protection Committee to review the radiation safety operations of the entire school.
5. Supervise radiation protection training.
6. Supervise the handling of various radiation accidents that occur in the school, and assist in investigating the causes and reporting to the Atomic Energy Commission.
7. Supervise annual radiation safety inspections at radiation experiment sites.

Article 4 The Association shall hold a meeting once every semester, and may hold extraordinary meetings when necessary.

Article 5 The meeting must be attended by more than half of the members before it can be convened; it must be approved by more than half of the members present before it can make a resolution.

Article 6 This Code shall be approved by the Executive Council and submitted to the Principal for promulgation and implementation. The same applies to revisions.
